Vice Chairman Owen opened the meeting at 7:30 pm

GENERAL COMMENTS Public comments of a general nature may be addressed at this time.

Richard Pagani of 6 Ivy Lane spoke.

Mr. Pagani spoke about the trash and fence along both sides of Wells Rd between Colonel Chester Dr. and Ivy Lane, and the culvert under Wells Rd.

The Town had recently replaced the fence along the North side of Wells Rd.

The Culvert under Wells Rd appears to be clogged.

Don Moisa stated that the Town's sidewalk inspector had walked both sides of Wells Rd. to inspect the sidewalks and had called Physical Services to pick up the trash.

The inspector would be determining who would be responsible for any sidewalk repairs.

Don Moisa would be contacting the State to get the culvert cleaned.

Application for Erosion and Sedimentation control plan certification.

Corey Garro PE of Close Jensen & Miller & William Griswold of Cedar Hill Cemetery represented the applicant.

Mr. Garro gave an overview of the proposed site work.

The area of the proposed mausoleum represents 0.2% of the 29 Acre watershed.

They are disturbing 0.6 acres.

To reduce the chance of erosion slopes are limited to 3:1, there will be silt sacs placed in all the catch basins, and they have shown silt fence along the low side of the site.

Commissioners requested that silt fence also be added around the stockpile area.

Motion by Commissioner Herold to Certify the Erosion/Sedimentation plan as submitted, seconded by Commissioner Kulpa with the following condition.

1. The plans be modified to show silt fence around the stockpile areas.

All voted in favor, motion passed.
