



All Commissioners voted in favor, (Commissioner Joseph Hallisey did not participate in discussions or vote on this application). Motion passed.

**Application No. 586-09, City of Hartford, Parcel No. 214-002, Hartford Ave.**

Application for maintenance activities to the Folly Brook Conduit, part of the Hartford Flood Control System.

Stuart H. Harris, P.E. Director of Structural Engineering; Joshua H. Wilson, Wetland Scientist of Fuss & O'Neill and Bob Umashankar, Civil Engineer, City of Hartford represented the applicant.

Mr. Harris presented several drawings and explained the proposed activity on the project. The project pertains to the Folly Brook Conduit, part of the Hartford Flood Control System, located along the Hartford/Wethersfield town line. The deteriorated portions of the conduit must be repaired or rehabilitated before it can be certified as being sound structural condition and functioning. The conduit is an existing utility therefore the work will be considered maintenance along this area. Temporary disturbance within the watercourse is required in order to gain access to the outfall and conduct maintenance activities.

The Commission recommended that the applicant modify the application to include revising the access route of the road avoiding abutting properties, or receiving written permission from the affected the property owners. Due to time constraints on this application, the Chairman will hold a Special Meeting when the modification on this application is received or authorization from affected property owners is received.

Motion by Commissioner Buck, seconded by Commissioner Hallisey to **TABLE** the application until receipt of acknowledgement of this application from applicable property owners. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion passed.
