### **SOCIAL & YOUTH SERVICES:**

- **Energy Assistance Program:** The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) is now open around the State. The program is designed to help off-set the winter heating costs of lower income households, especially those incomes that fall at or below 150% of the federal poverty guidelines; as well as households with elderly, disabled and/or children under the age of 6 with incomes between 150% and 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. Guidelines (based on the 2016 year): Family of 1 - \$33,132.22; Family of 2 - \$43,326.74 and Family of 3 - \$53,521.27. Wethersfield residents that are Renters may have \$12,000.00 or less in liquid assets and Homeowners may have \$15,000.00 or less in liquid assets. Wethersfield residents that fall within the guidelines may make an appointment with Social and Youth Services Department by calling (860) 721-2977. All applications are completed by appointment only.
- **Weekend Youth Meal Program:** If you have children in your home and are experiencing some financial hardship please contact Social & Youth Services about our new Weekend Youth Meal Program. A caregiver would be responsible for picking up a bag of food every Thursday or Friday. These bags would be filled with breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks for the kids to eat on the weekends.

## E. PROJECT UPDATES:

### ENGINEERING

- **Road Condition Assessment:** The Town has contracted with Vanesse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. of Wethersfield to evaluate 102 miles of Town roads to update the Town's existing pavement management software. This evaluation is typically conducted every five years to provide staff with updated information on road conditions throughout town for decision-making purposes. The visual road inspections are underway and should be completed in October.
- **Wolcott Hill Road Safety Improvements:** The Town plans to implement traffic calming measures along Wolcott Hill Road from Marmor Ct to Coleman Rd that will include installation of shoulder lines, removal of the existing sidewalk ramp at the intersection of Beverly Road, and installation of new concrete sidewalk ramps, painted crosswalk and associated signage at the north corner of the Clearfield Rd intersection. The Town anticipates this work will be completed by the Town's sidewalk and line striping contractors this fall.
- **Pavement Marking Program:** The Town has contracted with Atlantic Pavement Markings of Preston, CT through a Capital Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) bid for the annual restriping of all Town roads. Restriping of stop bars and crosswalks is expected to commence next week.
- **Crack Sealing Program:** The Town has contracted with Sealcoating of Braintree, MA off the State Bid for annual crack sealing of Town roads. Work has commenced and the contractor expects to complete all work by late October.
- **Wilkus Farm Parking Lots:** The Town plans to construct three gravel parking areas that will be located off Willow Street, Goff Road and Thornbush Road. The gravel parking lot originally planned on the west side of Willow St. has been eliminated and the proposed lot on the east side of the road will be expanded to accommodate more vehicles. Work will be completed by Town staff and is expected to begin next week for the lot located off Thornbush Rd.
- **LED Streetlights:** Staff has interviewed three firms for light purchase and LED conversion and is in the process of making a selection.
- **CT DOT Traffic Signal Improvements at Wolcott Hill Rd & Wells Rd and Maple St & Mill St Intersections:** Projects are substantially complete.
- **Reservoir Estates Subdivision:** Contractor has completed road subgrade improvements within Phase 1 limits and clearing of the drainage swale located north of Westmont Road. Installation of sanitary sewer and water distribution facilities is on hold pending final MDC approval.
- **Summer/Fall Paving Program:** Road paving operations for the following streets are expected to be complete this week and will be followed by curb and driveway apron replacement where required:


