Mooring Rental / Mooring Space Rental / Tender Cleat Rental – 2019 Application

Completed applications are to be submitted to the Wethersfield Parks and Rec office. Be sure to also provide a copy of your current boat registration and current declaration page of the insurance policy for your boat.

A **mooring rental** allows a boater to use one of the Town's permanent moorings.

A **mooring space rental** allows a boater to drop their own, approved, mooring tackle in a designated mooring space.

A **tender cleat** allows a boater to lock his/her tender to our dock.

Moorings/mooring spaces and tender cleats will be assigned on first-come-first-served basis. If there are more applications than space, a waiting list will be maintained. Those on the waiting list will be contacted, as space becomes available.

Mooring Rental / Mooring Space Rental / Tender Cleat Rental Rules – 2019

Application form must be completed in full and returned with the appropriate fee.

1. No one shall be permitted to use a mooring, mooring space or tender cleat in the Cove unless they have submitted a complete application, paid the registration fee and have been assigned a location.
2. Owners of boats occupying a mooring or mooring space must provide a copy of valid DMV registration and insurance policy that covers the 2019 boating season (May 25 – October 14). Name on application must match name on valid DMV registration.
3. Mooring rental registrants must attach an approved mooring pennant to the mooring with appropriate shackle as shown below, if not provided by the Town.
4. Mooring space registrants must attend a meeting with the Harbormaster or Deputy Harbormaster, possess mooring equipment in compliance with specifications provided below, display their boat registration number on a mooring buoy as specified on the reverse side, have mooring gear inspected and approved by the Harbormaster or Deputy Harbormaster and drop their mooring gear in the location assigned. Any mooring that is dropped without meeting the above requirements shall be removed by the town and shall become the property of the town.
5. Boats with permanently mounted propulsion systems including PWCs (jet skis) are not authorized for use as 'tenders to access moorings.' Any such boat, or PWC used as a tender, is subject to the same launch regulations and fees as all other such boats and PWCs.
6. Tender cleat registrants must display their tender cleat number in visible location on the inside of the transom of their tender and secure their tender to the tender cleat corresponding with number assigned.
7. Tender size should not exceed 12' in length and 3' in width.
8. Outboard motors are left on tenders at owner's risk (not recommended).
9. At the conclusion of our boating season all personal property including boats, moorings or tenders not removed from the Cove by Columbus Day will be seized by the Parks and Recreation Department, as they will obstruct the closing of our facility. The owners may also forfeit their privilege to use the Cove in the future.

MOORING PENNANT REQUIREMENTS

Mooring rental registrants must attach their boat to a mooring with an approved mooring pennant. The pennant must be attached to the mooring with appropriate shackle. The mooring pennant and attachment must meet the requirements described below and be approved by the Harbormaster. The pennant must be nylon line, 6 – 10 feet in length, and be of the diameter shown below:

BOAT LENGTH UNDER 24' = 1/2" DIA. | BOAT LENGTH 24' - 35' = 5/8" DIA. | BOAT LENGTH OVER 35' = 3/4" DIA.
